

Weather Summary/Forecast for the San Francisco Bay Area

Date: February 16, 200X
Time: 1130 PST

Summary: Currently, the Bay Area is experiencing mostly cloudy skies. Clouds will continue to increase and light rain will develop tonight as a weak storm moves ashore. Another storm system moving into the Pacific Northwest tomorrow night should spread more clouds and a chance of light rain into the northern Bay Area. In the longer term, the main storm track will continue to direct storms into Washington, Oregon and extreme Northern California through early next week.

36 Hour Forecast:

Today - Increasing clouds with light rain developing in the late afternoon. Highs in the upper 50's and lower 60's. Southeast winds to 10 mph.

Tonight - Light rain changing to showers after midnight. Southeast winds to 10 mph shifting to westerly overnight. Lows in the upper 40's and lower 50's.

Tomorrow - Partly cloudy in the morning with increasing clouds in the afternoon. Highs in the upper 50's and lower 60's. Winds becoming southerly 5 to 15 mph.

3 to 5 Day Outlook:

Mostly cloudy Friday night with a few light showers or sprinkles especially northern Bay Area. Partly cloudy Saturday. Becoming fair Sunday. Partly cloudy Monday. Mild with light and variable winds through the period.

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
